
LOVEWORKS DOES READ ACROSS AMERICA 2024!

The IEA-NEA LOVEWORKS -- Joy and Justice: Abolitionist Teaching in the Classroom has incorporated the goals of Read Across America and wants to provide funds to purchase diverse books for your classroom/school!

Why diverse books? Diverse books serve as mirrors (opportunities to see self) and windows (opportunities to see others) of different human emotions and lived experiences. This helps to build community and increase students' empathy. Often, these stories and narratives highlight those students whose voices have not traditionally been heard.

Who can participate? IEA members – educators, (especially Early Career), clinicians, librarians, Educational Support Professionals – are encouraged to apply!

What is the process? Complete the application survey which requests demographic and contact information, a statement of need and implementation, and potential stakeholder participation. Complete and submit by March 15, 2024.

Those selected will be given funds to purchase books directly from Teaching from Change. Funds dispersed directly to the member will require the invoice and receipt submitted to IEA for record. Funds dispersed directly to school administration will not require submission of invoice and receipt.



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
